Features

GEM Dashboard

Track students last completed process entered in the GEM module.

Screening Panel

Track screening dates, screening assessments, source of gifted referral, and parent consent.

Reciprocity Panel

Track reciprocity district or military base, reciprocity date, and testing information for these transfer students.

Testing Panel

Enter assessment types and scores to automatically calculate a student's gifted eligibility based on the customizable assessment matrix.

Eligibility Panel

Track gifted eligibility, parent consent to serve, gifted status, effective date, and gifted service plan. Data is automatically written to line of enrollment for State Reporting.

GEM Notes

Area to input notes concerning the student's gifted eligibility information. .
